You are also expected to attend the opening session of the conference on Thursday, March 19th at 5:45pm that evening. Your names will appear on the opening session slide show and you will be acknowledged and asked to stand. It is preferable if you try to find seating in the first few rows.

1. Do I have to be an ADAA member to be eligible to apply?

2. What additional information will I need to supply once I have been selected?

ADAA will be in touch regarding any additional information we might need if you are selected for the program.

3. How do I register for the conference?

You will receive an email with a special code to register for the conference once the CDLP awardees have been announced.

4. Does ADAA provide travel awards to the Conference?

No, each awardee is responsible for covering all travel, hotel and meal expenses. The CDLP program provides complimentary full Conference registration.

5. Are any meals included?

- ADAA will provide a complimentary breakfast and lunch on Thursday. Please email goved@adaa.org if you have any allergies or dietary/health restrictions.
- Complimentary breakfast will be provided to all conference attendees on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- Early Career attendees are invited to a complimentary lunch on Saturday.

6. I am a Research Track Awardee. Do I have to present a poster?

The poster presentation is meant to be helpful to your career. We highly recommend that you take advantage of this unique opportunity. However, if you decide not to present, we ask that you inform us so that we can inform mentors and the ADAA Conference team.

7. I am a Research Track Awardee. What should my research track presentation cover?

You should prepare a 10-15-minute slide presentation (8-10 slides) to cover the content of the abstract you submitted OR a proposed research study, including: background, aims/hypotheses, methods, findings (or anticipated findings) and future directions/alternative approaches. Please bring your presentation with you to the CDLP program on a USB flash drive.

8. I am a Research Track Awardee. Does my poster and/or research track presentation need to be the same as the abstract I submitted?

The poster and/or research track presentation are meant to be helpful to your career. This means that you may change the subject. However, we ask that you let us know of this change as soon as possible so that we can inform mentors and the ADAA Conference team.

9. I will not be able to attend this year's CDLP program. May I request a deferral?

If you are unable to attend the CDLP program in the year of your selection, you can defer your attendance to the following year (with the approval of the CDLP Committee) without the need to reapply. The deferral is available for one year only.
