### 2020 CDLP FAQs for Mentors

ADAA (Kesha Patel) will provide both mentors and CDLP award winners with regular email regular updates (ie. the program agenda, any materials needed, etc.).

**1. Do I have to be an ADAA member to be eligible to apply as a mentor?**

Yes. To become a member, visit the [ADAA membership page](#).

**2. Does ADAA reimburse for conference or travel?**

No. Mentors, are required to register for the Conference, book hotel and travel on your own. ADAA is unable to reimburse for these costs.

**3. When will I be matched with my mentee?**

You will be matched with your mentee approximately one month before the ADAA conference.

**4. How often should I be in touch with my mentee?**

You should contact your mentee prior to the meeting to introduce yourself and ask if they would like you to make any connections for them at the conference. After the conference, please connect with them 2 to 3 times to stay in touch and encourage them to get involved with ADAA.

**5. I am an individual Research Track mentor. Do I need to attend for the whole CDLP Day?**

As an individual Research Track mentor, you are not required to attend the whole CDLP Day. However, it is preferred that you attend the core sessions (you will be provided with an agenda for the CDLP

program a few weeks before the event). If you won't be attending for the full day, we appreciate you getting in touch with your mentee to see when you can meet during the conference.

***Note: Not all individual mentors are small group mentors.***

#### **6. I am a Small Group Research Track mentor. What is expected of me?**

As a small group Research Track mentor, you are expected to work with a small group of awardees in the morning and afternoon. This will involve reviewing awardees' research presentations and sharing feedback on various career aspects.

***Note: Not all small group mentors are individual mentors.***
